# Early Childhood Mental Health Collective

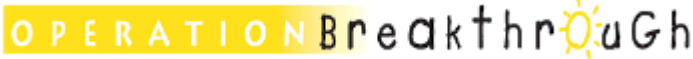

Aims to improve life outcomes for children, caregivers, and staff through systems coordination and comprehensive mental health services in the Kansas City Metro.

- Organizations can apply for up to \$8 million
- One lead agency
- Can be collaborative application representing multiple agencies
- Grants will be awarded for a three-year period

- Onsite mental health services
- Internship pipeline
- Onsite clinical directors/coordinators
- Referral management
- Training
- Governance
- Resource distribution
- Evaluation

# Additional Considerations

---

- Lead applicant must be a 501c3 public charity, however partners do not need to be
- Collaborative proposals are encouraged
- Capacity to carry out scope of work
- Capital or renovation requests will not be considered



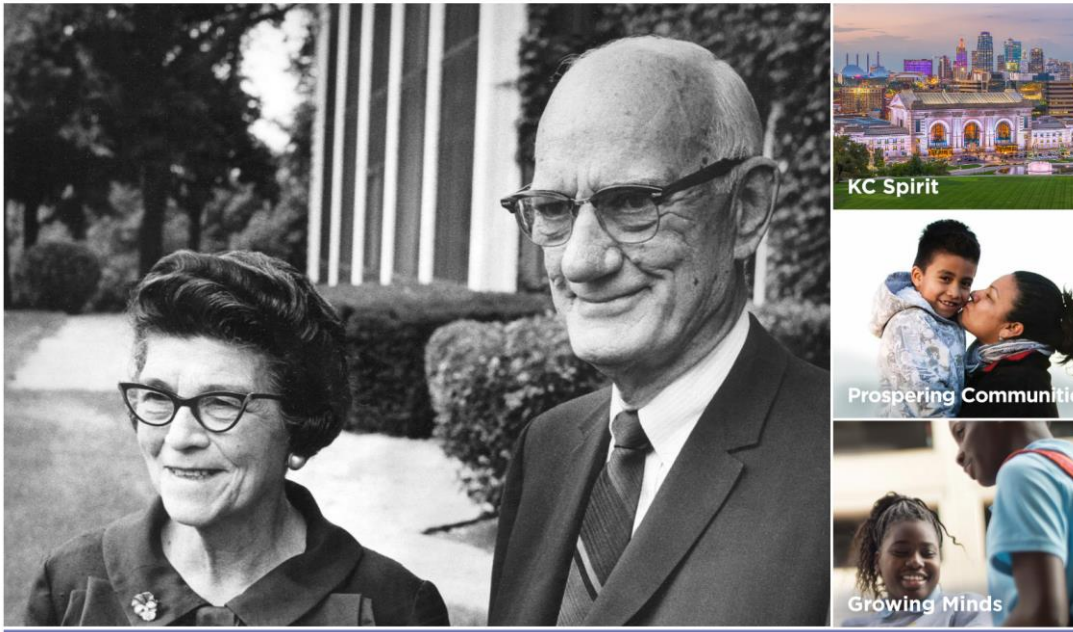
# Application Process and Timeline


